Dennis was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul Lutheran Church. He attended Arlington High School from 1956 to 1960. Entered the military September of 1962, was in the Air National Guard Reserves from 1962 to 1968 and the Air Force Reserves from 1974 to 2002 and attained the rank of Chief Master Sergeant which he held for 16 years, totaling 34 years.

Dennis graduated from CE School of Commerce May 1970 and also graduated from the University of Omaha May 1974 with a degree in Actuarial Science. He attended the University of Michigan through classes taken at Offutt AFB in Bellevue, Nebraska.

Dennis was employed for many years at Mutual of Omaha as an Analyst. He

was later employed at Methodist Hospital Corporate Office and was asked to join in on building projects at Divine Shepherd Lutheran Church, as well as serving as the Lutheran Layman's Scholarship Chairman. He was also involved in Desert Ministries in Omaha.

Dennis served for 25 years as an inspector for the Douglas County Election office as well as other city and neighborhood boards.

He was on the original board established to bring closed captioned television to the local deaf community and was Vice President of the Arlington Education Foundation for a number of years.

Dennis was an avid Husker fan holding season tickets for 34 years and was also a world traveler going to all the continents but one.
