Dick enlisted in the Army on the 23rd of June 1953. He served as a medic in Camp Polk Louisiana and was sent to Germany in 1954.

On June 8, 1957, he married Marilyn and the couple resided in Omaha.

On December 5, 1980, he married Deborah L. Walentine and the couple lived near Fort Calhoun for 34 years.

After Debby's death on February 5, 2014, he remarried Marilyn on July 11, 2015. The couple resided near Fort Calhoun until the time of Dick's death.

Mr. Walentine was a member of the Fort Calhoun Presbyterian Church, the

Nebraska Thoroughbred Breeders Association and the Nebraska Cattlemen's Beef Association.
